

As instructed by the Director of Health and Family Welfare Services, Puducherry vide reference cited, the students of all the Higher Educational Institutions in the U.T. of Puducherry and their parents shall be informed to create Health ID under the National Digital Health Mission (NDHM), an Government of India initiative.

2. The instructions to create the Health ID shall be disseminated to all the students and their parents. A nodal officer shall be appointed by each College and the details of the Nodal Officer as one point contact shall be intimated to the parents. The Nodal Officer shall ensure 100% registration of the students and their families. The compliance report shall be sent to the Director, DHFWS, Puducherry at **dms.pon@nic.in** under intimation to this Directorate before **18.01.2021**. The Head of Institutions are instructed to include the Health ID details on the ID card of the students in the upcoming academic years.

National Digital Health Mission has been launched under National Health Mission recently. The National Digital Health Mission (NDHM) is a Government of India initiative, aimed at developing the backbone for a unified digital health infrastructure. Among other objectives, NDHM seeks to bridge the gap amongst multiple stakeholders that are a part of the healthcare ecosystem.

To create a Health Digital Ecosystem, creation of Health ID by individuals and Health Facility registry to be updated parallel for the following benefits to be availed for all citizens of India:

1. Citizens can choose the nearby Health Facility.
2. Telemedicine for patients from all over the country.
3. Provide digital health records to patients. Ease of access on generating old records.
4. Ease in empanelment with insurance agencies, TPAs.

Each Health ID will be linked to a health data consent manager (such as NDHM) which will be used to seek the patient's consent and allow for seamless flow of health information from the Personal Health Records module.

Registration for health id is an integral part of NDHM, a flagship program of Govt and hence the Higher and Technical Education Department is requested to communicate to all colleges (Both Government and Private) by sending Circular (Format of the Circular is enclosed herewith) to all the parents for creating Health IDs for all students and parents.

Further, each college may be requested to nominate a Nodal Officer to ensure that all students are creating their Health IDs along with their family members. Further, in the upcoming academic years, it may be instructed to the colleges that the Health IDs may be one of the items in their ID cards.

Further, the above said process may be extended to the teaching staff, non-teaching staff, and their families also. Individuals can also obtain their Health IDs by self-registration through the web link <https://healthid.ndhm.gov.in/register>.
