Already in RUSA Phase-I, approval has been accorded by MHRD(RUSA) for the Upgradation of autonomous Pondicherry Engineering College to Technological university and out of Rs. 55.00 Crores Rs. 28.75 Crores have been received.		
Component -2: Creation of universities by conversion of colleges in a cluster (Rs. 55.00 Crores)		
Norms: 1. To bring 3-5 colleges which have the required Academic and Administrative autonomy (but do not have the power to award degree) and convert them to a university through an Act of state Legislation. 2. Colleges fulfilling conditions of autonomy under UGC Autonomous College regulations 2018 of the UGC will be eligible. 3. Colleges with high Teacher-Students Ratio, PG departments, and having filled 85% of their sanctioned faculty positions are eligible. 4.
